The contents of our Zonta Birthing Kit

The Warren Zonta Club will be assembling birthing kits on Thursday, January 20 at Blair Corporate Headquarters in town. Arrive anytime between 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. Use the Third Street entrance, across from the Fire Station. Either Sara Swanson or Melinda Johnson will be there to greet you, and direct you to the cafeteria. There may also be some Blair Associates joining us for the work.

ZONTA INTERNATIONAL BIRTHING KITS

Birthing Kits save lives and reduce suffering by providing for a clean birth. They are distributed in remote regions of developing countries for home births. Contents are contained in a small (1 qt.) plastic press seal bag and include:

- 1 m x 1m square plastic sheeting
(for mother to lie on)
- 1 piece of soap
- 1 pair of latex gloves
- 3 cords to tie the umbilical cord
- 1 razor blade
- 5 gauze squares

Benefits of using birthing kits:

- Improves maternal health
- Reduces child mortality
- Protects midwives from contracting infectious diseases by wearing the latex gloves & using the razor
- Empowers women
