American's Silent Culture Human Trafficking Part II

This information is from Deputy Elizabeth Fides, Erie Co. NY – the speaker at International Women's Day on March.7th, sponsored by Jamestown Zonta, AAUW, and JCC. -edited by Phyllis Wright

How & Why they end up trafficked?

Recruiting – with today's technology of face book, cell phones, internet the traffickers hack to find girls messaging of hating parents, "meet me at the Mall" or "the game" destinations," need money, modeling opportunities, jobs, etc.. They read girl's self esteem problems, contact the girl, and give promises of better independent life.

Harboring – informal or formal gangs

Moving – promising better industry or agricultures jobs, or better prostitution clients.

Buying person – for drug payments or parents sell because unable to take care of children .

Kinds of trafficking operations:

Domestic servitude – nannies, housekeeping, mistress

Organ harvesting - especially kidneys

Forced labor – restaurant, hotel, factory workers, begging, agriculture, corporations, residential and commercial brothels, etc.

Sexual exploitation – international marriages, pornography, escorts,

Debt bondage – drug payment, threats to family, etc.

Victims may be runways, homeless youth, those in poverty or wealthy girl from a family with past sexual history, debt to dealers, adults with low self esteem and trapped in a relationship.

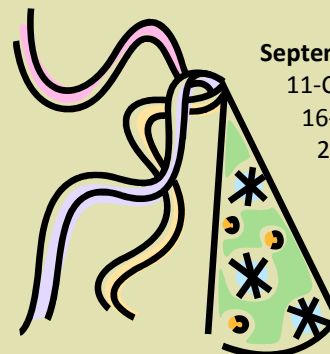
